

INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER REGULATION 2023/2854 ON HARMONISED RULES FOR FAIR ACCESS TO AND USE OF DATA (DATA ACT)

AIR HANDLING UNITS

1. The air handling units offered by VTS sp. z o.o., with its registered office in Gdańsk (Aleja Grunwaldzka 472A, 80-309 Gdańsk; hereinafter: "VTS"), are mechanical devices enabling controlled air circulation (hereinafter: "Units"), equipped with a communication module enabling connection to the mHMI 2.0 application and the mHMI PRO portal (hereinafter: "Application" or "Portal" respectively) via the Internet or Bluetooth technology, constitute connected products within the meaning of the Data Act.
2. The Units collect data on air temperature and energy consumption, including in particular the following categories of data:
 - a) temperature (of supply air, exhaust air, outdoor air, in chambers, on heat exchangers, of the heating/cooling medium, etc.);
 - b) air humidity (if humidity sensors are present);
 - c) pressure (e.g. pressure difference across filters, pressure in ducts);
 - d) air flow (flow rates in m³/h, fan speeds);
 - e) setpoint and measured levels (e.g. set room temperature vs. actual);
 - f) the binary states of sensors and devices (signals indicating, for example, the activation of a smoke detector, the status of the heater control, fan ON/OFF, damper opening, etc.).
3. The data listed above is generated in the Control Units and transmitted to the VTS servers continuously, at set intervals. The amount of data generated varies depending on how the Control Units are used.
4. The data collected by the Control Units is stored within the VTS infrastructure.
5. The user has full access to the data sent from the Control Units via the App or the Portal. The Portal allows the user to generate a .csv file, which can be saved locally on the user's device.
6. The detailed terms and conditions of use for the App and the Portal are available within the App or the Portal. The user may also obtain information prior to activating access by contacting VTS at: vtscloud@vtsgroup.com.
7. Upon expiry of the agreement under which the user uses the Control Centre, the Portal or the Application, VTS will retain the data for a further period of 30 days. After this period has elapsed, VTS will delete all data collected and processed as a result of the user's actions.
